Instructions

- 1. Keep track of your mileage and hours and record the information below.
- 2. Count all birds in your section, including Canada geese and crows.
- 3. Take a photograph of species marked with (*) if possible. The state CBC coordinator prefers a photograph of rare species and no longer accepts the MOU Request for Documentation form.
- 4. A mid-day tally will be held at Quarry Hill Nature Center from noon to 1 p.m. Bring your own lunch.
- 5. An end-of-day tally will be held at the Nature Center starting around 4:45 p.m. All participants are invited to attend. The tally will include a light potluck supper with soup and bread provided.
- 6. If you won't be attending the end-of-day tally, please drop your **registration form and tally form** off at the Nature Center by the end of the day, or e-mail them to **Clifford Hansen** at clhroch@yahoo.com. A legible photo of a form is fine.
- 7. Each team should decide what Covid precautions to follow. National Audubon recommends wearing masks indoors and carpooling only for members of the same household or social "pod".
